Programming

Adults are responsible for their boys while our staff is available to support and assist if requested or needed. Campers are encouraged to do every activity to the best of their ability; however, participation is up to the camper.

Recreation

Required Forms

Lodging

We offer two different lodging options to choose from at the time of registration.

Cabin: No Extra Charge!

Our modern cabins can have up to 14 people in a cabin and is a great way to gain community. With heating, A/C, and indoor bathrooms, your stay at Caraway will be cozy and comfortable. Make sure to bring your own linens.

Hotel Room: \$75 upcharge

We offer a limited number of private, hotel lodging for you and your son(s) to share in our Conference Center. All activities will be held on the camp side of our property. Don't wait! These rooms fill up fast. Register today to secure your private room.

Lost and Found

Please label all of your son(s)' and your belongings with your name. Any lost and found items will be at a table during check out. If you do happen to leave something behind, we can mail it to you for the cost of shipping and a \$5 handling fee.

Special Dietary Needs

At Camp Caraway, we take food allergies very seriously. Our kitchen staff accommodate and provide alternative meal options as much as possible. We can typically work around most allergies including gluten, dairy, soy, nuts, egg, and corn. It is important to note that our facility is NOT a nut free, dairy free, soy-free, egg-free environment. While our dining team is willing to support those with dietary needs, we cannot guarantee that there is no cross contamination.

The Post

The Post Store will be open daily. Items approximate costs include: snacks, ice cream & drinks (\$2-\$3 each), short sleeve T-shirts (\$15-\$20), Caraway Hats (\$20), water bottles (\$10-18), sweatshirts (\$20-30), backpacks (\$10), assorted toys (\$5), and more. We accept cash and card.

Tobacco Free: Our Father-Son Camps are tobacco/vape free with the exception of the designated smoking gazebo located on the backside of the Conference Center. Thank you for honoring this throughout the weekend!



Arrival

Arrival is between 4:30–5:30 pm Friday October 17th. Please do not arrive earlier than 4pm. If you must arrive later than 5:30 pm, please let us know in advance. Supper will be at 6PM in the Dining Hall.

Our physical address is 4756 Caraway Mountain Rd., Sophia, NC 27350. Once you go through the main gate from Caraway Mountain Rd, turn onto Conference Center Drive and drive until you come to a fork. A staff member will direct you to check in.

- Registration– You may register online at www.campcaraway.org. with a credit card. Registration is first come–first serve. We will post online when any programs are full.

- Refunds– Deposits are non–refundable. Balances are not refundable after the balance due date except in the event of illness, injury, or death in the immediate family the week before or during the camp.
