FAQ

Will my child have their cell phone?

No, they will be asked to hand their cell phone over to their program leader. We will give you the personal contact information of multiple leaders if you need to get in contact with your child.



Since 1963 we have been creating unforgettable camp experiences at Caraway Conference Center and Camps, and this tradition continues in the Timothy Program. The Timothy Program is a high school leadership development program for teenagers ages 15-18. Our mission is to introduce high school students to camp ministry, challenge them to grow in team work and servant leadership, and encourage them to grow in their faith.

Pre Camp Orientation

Pre-camp orientation weekend is June 5-7th, Session 1 will have a short break afterwards and will stay. This will be a time for the high school students to tour camp, learn more about day-to-day activities, meet other Timothy Program Participants, and meet the Timothy Program Coordinators.

Your camper will also receive their book/material they will be reading over the time they are here. There will also be a parent video meeting to discuss and answer any questions for the program.

Driving

Your camper will be allowed to drive themselves to and from camp. If they are riding with another camper, we must have an email from each parent giving permission for the campers to ride together.

Special Food Needs

If your camper has special diet requests or allergies to food, please put this on your students health form. We will work to provide your camper with the assistance they need. If your camper would like to bring snacks, they must be in a sealed, plastic box.

Sleeping Arrangements

Your camper will be staying at Camp Mundo Vista. They will be in a cabin with twin bunk beds and their same-gendered Program Coordinator and other Timothy Program participants. Campers will be transported back and forth from Camp Caraway to Camp Mundo Vista as needed.



Safety and First Aid

Our staff are trained very thoroughly to do their jobs well. Each staff is trained in First Aid and CPR. There is basic first aid kits in most buildings.

We will have a Registered Nurse on call if needed. Our trained staff will be responsible for camper medication administration and will be available to assist during injuries or emergencies.

Your camper cannot keep any medication with them in the Cabin. Please put your camper's medication (prescribed/over the counter), supplements and vitamins in a plastic bag with their name on it. Please list all ingestible medication on the camper health form, we will not distribute medications not listed. Our nursing staff or Full Time Staff will distribute medication per the perscription.

We provide at no cost most common over the counter medications and the Nurse or an administrator will follow our medical protocol about administering medications to campers. If a camper parent needs to be called, we will make sure you know what is going on

Sunday Arrivals/Friday Pick-up

Please Label all items with the camper's name

- *Bible*
- *Black shorts for camp uniform on Monday*
- *Notebook*
- *Pen/Pencil*
- *Lightweight backpack to carry personal items such as water bottle, sun screen, money, towel, etc.*
- *Clothes (t-shirts & shorts)*
- *1 pair of long pants*
- *Underclothes*
- *Twin sheets & blanket or a sleeping bag*
- *Pillow*
- *3 towels (2 for bathing and 1 for swim time)*
- *Toiletry articles (toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, soap, etc.)*
- *Insect repellent*
- *Sunscreen*
- *1 pair of tennis shoes (that can get dirty)*
- *Shower shoes or flip flops (not to be worn during recreation times)*
- *1 light weight rain coat or poncho*
- *2 large dirty clothes bags (1 for dirty clothes and 1 for wet clothes)*
- *1 light jacket or sweatshirt*
- *1 pair of pajamas or sleep wear*
- *1 bathing suit (very modest one piece)*
- *Flashlight with extra batteries*
- *Water bottle (we will have Caraway bottles & hydration packs for sale at The Post Store)*
- *Letter writing supplies*
- *Camp store and missions offering money in a plastic zip bag labeled with their name and age*

What Not to Bring

- *Any electronics, mobile phones, tablets, etc. (staff can store camper phones in office)*
 - *Any animals or pets*
 - *Fireworks of any kind*
 - *Firearms or weapons*
 - *Any type of illegal drugs, tobacco, vapes, or alcohol*
 - *Personal recreation or athletic equipment is not allowed unless you have specific permission.*
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
