Programming

Lodging

We offer two different lodging options to choose from at the time of registration.

Cabin: No Extra Charge!

Our modern cabins can have up to 12 people in a cabin and is a great way to gain community. With heating, A/C, and indoor bathrooms, your stay at Mundo Vista will be cozy and comfortable. Make sure to bring your own linens.

Hotel style rooms: \$60 upcharge

We offer private, hotel-style rooms for you and your daughter(s) to share. Some rooms have Jack and Jill bathrooms that are shared with an adjacent room. Don't wait! These rooms fill up fast. Register today to secure your private room.

Special Dietary Needs

At Camp Mundo Vista, we take food allergies very seriously. Our chef and kitchen staff accommodate and provide alternative meal options as much as possible. We can typically work around most allergies including gluten, dairy, soy, nuts, egg, and corn. It is important to note that our facility is NOT a nut free, dairy free, soy-free, egg-free environment. While our dining team is willing to support those with dietary needs, we cannot guarantee that there is no cross contamination.
